

Fondazione Milano Cortina 2026 Privacy Policy

Following the conclusion of the Milano Cortina 2026 Winter Olympic and Paralympic Games, the processing of personal data by the Foundation has ceased and personal data has been progressively deleted from the systems. Only the processing activities strictly necessary for the following purposes remain active: (i) managing existing contractual relationships with users who purchased or used tickets for the Games or who submitted their information as part of specific initiatives (so-called expression of interest); (ii) the technical operation of this website.

Personal data – as defined by data protection legislation (General Data Protection Regulation No. 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 and Legislative Decree No. 196 of 30 June 2003, as amended from time to time – jointly the “**Privacy Legislation**”) – means any information that directly or indirectly identifies the user as a natural person (“**Data**”) and is processed through this website (the “**Site**”) by Fondazione Milano Cortina 2026, acting as data controller pursuant to the Privacy Legislation.

This Privacy Notice may be updated to reflect any changes in the residual processing activities still in progress or amendments to applicable legislation. The date of the last update is indicated at the bottom of this document.

Data Controller and Data Protection Officer (or “DPO”)

Fondazione Milano Cortina 2026, with registered office at Piazza Tre Torri 3, Milan, Tax Code No. 97866790153, VAT No. 11199200962 (“**Milano Cortina 2026**” or the “**Foundation**”).

Data Collected by Milano Cortina 2026

In the context of the residual processing activities still active, the Controller processes the following types of data:

- **Identification and contact data:** for example, e-mail address, IP address, etc., communicated during browsing or through messages sent by e-mail to the e-mail addresses with the milanocortina2026.org domain. Additional Data, such as first name, surname, place and date of birth, may be communicated to Milano Cortina 2026 through registration, for example, via the forms available on the Site, for which, depending on the processing, a specific privacy notice may be published.
- **Browsing data:** The IT systems and software used to operate the Site automatically acquire, during their normal operation, certain Data whose transmission is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified users but, by its very nature, could allow user identification if combined with other data. This category of data includes, in particular, IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the Site, URI (*Uniform Resource Identifier*) addresses, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the server response (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the user, the operating system, and the IT environment. This information is collected through cookies as described below.

General Purposes of the Collection of Your Personal Data by Milano Cortina 2026

Data is collected and used for various purposes, and the user will be informed directly on the Data collection pages. In general, Data is collected on the basis of the following legal grounds and for the following purposes:

- A. for the performance of a contractual relationship or pre-contractual measures taken at the user’s request:** namely (i) to facilitate the user where they need to enter their data in forms, where published on the Site, dedicated to the use, under the terms prescribed by the specific pages, of the services described, or (ii) to provide the content and information requested by the user;

- B. to comply with legal, accounting, and tax obligations** and, unless the user objects and within the limits of their interests and rights, to manage the Controller's organisational and operational needs;
- C. Where applicable, to establish, exercise, or defend the Controller's rights in out-of-court and/or judicial proceedings.**

Cookies

The Foundation's web page is hosted on the technological infrastructure of the International Olympic Committee ("IOC"), which therefore directly installs its own and/or third-party cookies on the User's device during browsing (the cookie policy is available here: [Cookie Policy | Olympics.com](#)). Processing is therefore carried out by the IOC acting as an independent data controller under the GDPR.

Data Recipients

Milano Cortina 2026 may disclose the Data to (i) those who may access the data by virtue of provisions of law under European Union law or the law of the Member State to which the Controller is subject; (ii) entities performing activities ancillary to the purposes indicated above, and specifically, companies providing IT assistance and consultancy services, professionals, and consultants; as well as (iii) employees, designated as persons acting under the authority of the Controller pursuant to Article 29 of the GDPR or as System Administrators.

Data Retention Periods

Following the conclusion of the Foundation's activities, all personal data has been deleted from the systems, with the exception of data necessary to: (i) comply with legal, accounting, or tax obligations; (ii) manage residual contractual relationships with users who purchased or used tickets for the Games or provided their information as part of specific initiatives (so-called expression of interest); (iii) establish or defend rights in judicial or out-of-court proceedings. Such data is retained for the period strictly necessary to pursue the relevant purposes and, in any event, not beyond the applicable statutory limitation periods. Once such periods have elapsed, the data will be permanently and securely deleted.

Automated Decision-Making Processes

The Controller does not intend to use automated decision-making processes.

Security Measures and Transfers to Third Countries

The data collected by Milano Cortina 2026 as data controller, for the purposes listed in the preceding paragraph, is protected by appropriate technical and organisational measures against the risks of unauthorised access to or disclosure of your data, in compliance with applicable laws.

Through the use of our suppliers, data may be transferred to third countries outside the European Union (EU) or the European Economic Area (EEA). Where applicable, and if the third country does not benefit from an adequacy decision adopted by the European Commission, the suppliers have adopted instruments governing such transfers in compliance with applicable laws, including the applicable standard contractual clauses adopted by the European Commission. Each supplier and/or third party adopts appropriate technical and organisational measures for the protection of personal data.

Your Rights Regarding Your Data

Please note that, except for users who will fill in the forms on the Site, the processing activities by the Controller have ceased; however, it is – in any case – possible to send a request to privacy@milanocortina2026.org.

Furthermore, the user has the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Supervisory Authority for the protection of personal data, as provided for by Article 77 of the GDPR, or to seek a judicial remedy (Article 79 of the GDPR).
