



- 50% discount for the individual and 1 guardian: Disabled (Grade 1-3) * Wheelchair seats are 50% off the regular price (discount applicable for the wheelchair user and 1 accompanying person)
- 40% discount for individuals only : youth (including elementary, middle, and high school students)
- **Preschool children** : free admission for children under 36 months





Traffic Control Zone





PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED ITEMS (SPECTATORS)

The prohibited and restricted items policy applies to all individuals and spectators registered for the Gangwon 2024 Winter Youth Olympic Games.

In accordance to this policy, measures will be taken to prohibit, restrict, or permit the entry of items into the competition venues and non-competition venues.

Operation of the Policy in accordance with the Following Prohibited and Restricted Items

Whether an item is permitted to be brought in is indicated with the symbols [X-prohibited, R-restricted, O-permitted].

Prohibited items are subject to the principle under any circumstances, and restricted items are allowed to be brought in only under certain circumstances

discipline in which athletes push the sled quickly and run the first 30m for acceleration, get on board, and manoeuvre with control lines as the sleigh slides down at an average speed of 120 km

A discipline in which athletes race down a course that is equally divided into uphill, downhill, and level grounds

Nordic Combined

A discipline that combines cross-country skiing and shooting requires the athletes to ski a certain distance with a rifle on their backs and to shoot at designated shooting ranges

Ice Hockey

A discipline where athletes on skates compete for speed on a 400m indoor ice rink track
